


2022 English Summer Reading Guide: English 1 (Both Levels) - All Incoming 9th Graders

Instructions:

- Read *Dear Martin* by Nic Stone before the first day of school. **Obtain the physical book, not an** ebook. For most in-class work related to the book, you will not be able to use your iPad, so you need your own physical copy.
 - **NOTE:** Students who use an audiobook to support reading should read along in their physical copy while listening. Students should not use only an audiobook.
- Annotate while you read to slow down and track your thinking. See the questions in the assignment below for guidance on what you might think about while reading.
- Complete the assignment linked below. This will be submitted for a grade the first week of school. Your English teacher will instruct you on how to submit it once school starts.
