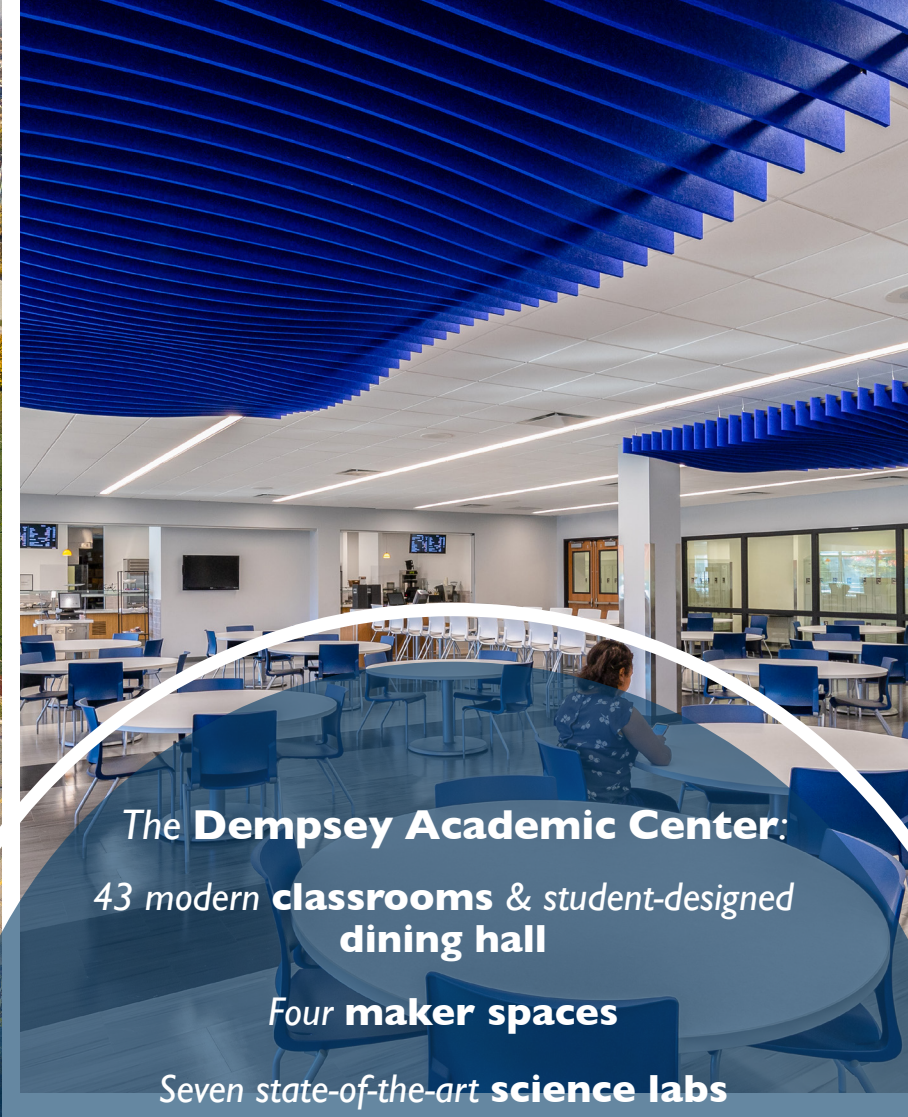

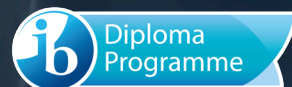
# See yourself excel

The STEAM Department (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Math) is comprised of instruction in visual arts, media arts, theater, music, engineering, design and computer science. The Department adopts an interdisciplinary approach to learning that develops critical thinking and creativity using state of the art technology, fully equipped art and sculpture studio, engineering and fabrication lab, computer science lab and music studio. Students create their own projects in robotics, visual and fine arts, documentary film, computer programming, engineering and design. Freshmen have the opportunity to begin exploring our STEAM course offerings through a variety of introductory level Art, Performing Arts, and Computer Science course offerings.

DePaul College Prep is proud to offer environmental science courses, which include opportunities to work with our thriving organic garden. In our Sustainable Urban Food Systems & the Culinary Arts course, students investigate the processes of obtaining, growing, and cooking our food. We prepare the students to create a greener world by focusing on sustainability, regenerative farming, environmental activism, and food accessibility. Beyond planting and caring for the garden, students also learn the skills to effectively prepare these foods in the kitchen.

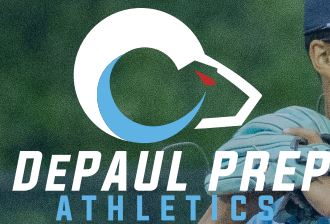

## learning support

DePaul College Prep is committed to providing curricular support to students with diagnosed learning differences throughout the school. Learning specialists are able to offer targeted support in reading comprehension, written expression, math, and executive functioning. Instructional support is provided inside and outside the classroom.

Learning specialists manage individualized classroom and testing accommodations, maintain close communication with teachers, parents, and outside professionals, and help students become independent learners. Students are eligible for learning support services if they have a diagnosed learning disability and/or ADHD that are included in an IEP, 504 Plan, or private evaluation. Documentation must be submitted to DePaul College Prep in order to receive specialized support.

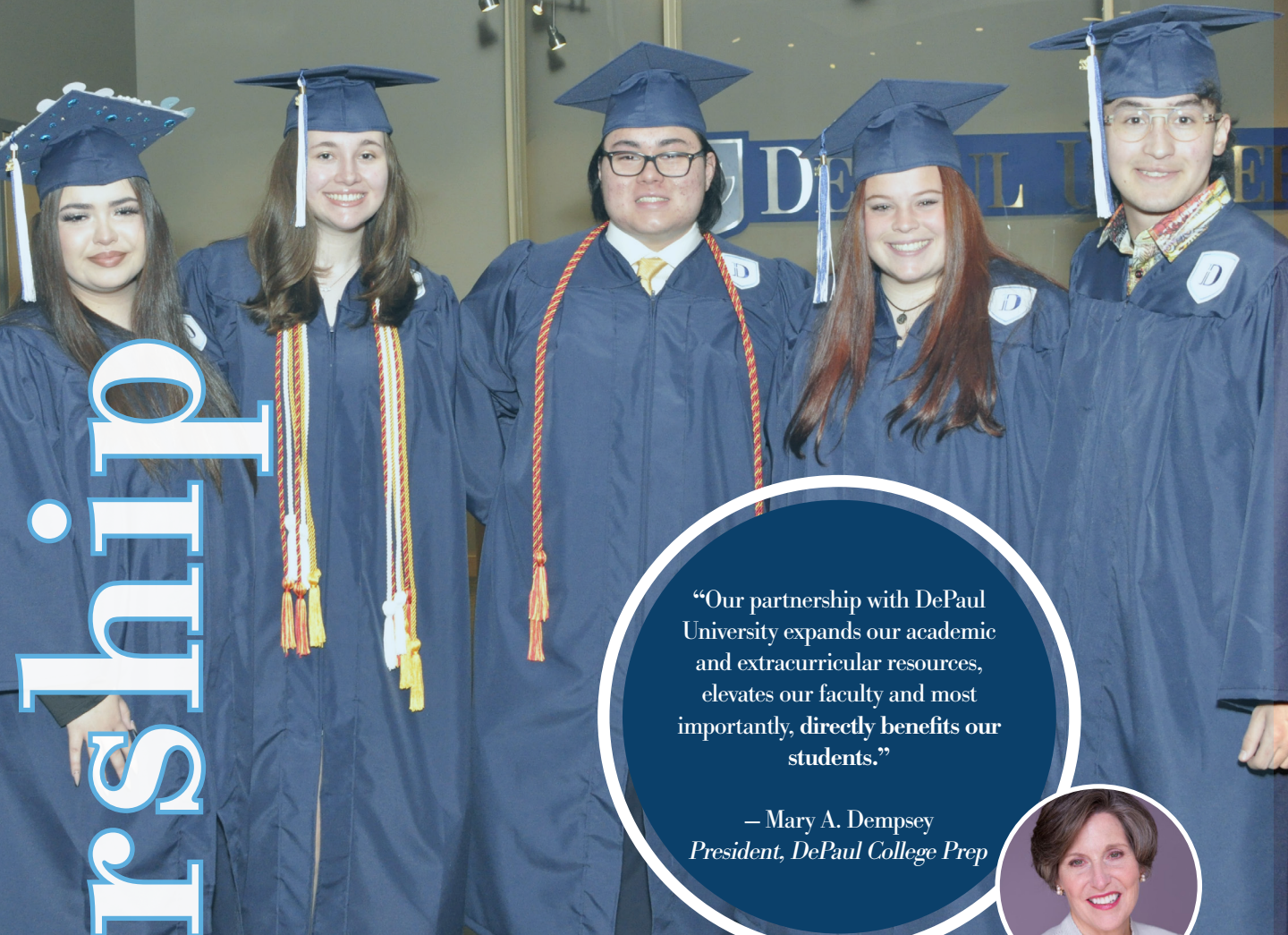
## E.D.G.E

The EDGE program (Every DePaul Graduate Excels) is a structured support program which provides a focused space to complete schoolwork and receive assistance from EDGE teachers within a student's daily schedule. Our team of EDGE teachers administer student specific support in math, reading, and writing, and executive functioning. Eligibility for EDGE is based on Title I rules and requires signed parent permission.

DePaul College Prep is a community anchor in the heart of the north side of Chicago, surrounded by the neighborhoods of North Center, Roscoe Village, Lakeview, Logan Square, Avondale, Irving Park, Lincoln Park and Lincoln Square.

Many students walk or ride their bike to campus. Located on Campbell Ave. at Belmont, DePaul Prep is accessible via the CTA Red, Brown, or Blue line trains, and the #152 Addison, #52 Kedzie, #77 Belmont, and #49 Western buses.
